



## I AM REDEEMED

Say it with me, I AM REDEEMED. This time say it loud enough so every demon can hear you. I AM REDEEMED! Now that we have that out of the way, what does it mean to be redeemed?

Christ purchased our freedom and redeemed us from the curse of the Law and its condemnation by becoming a curse for us—for it is written, “CURSED IS EVERYONE WHO HANGS [crucified] ON A TREE (cross) Galatians 3:13 Amplified.

The word ‘redeemed’ in this scripture is the Greek word ‘eksagorázō’.
