Grace and Peace to you all. This is the day that the Lord has made, and we shall rejoice and be glad in it. We greet you in the name of our one eternal Lord Jesus Christ.

Beloved, what is God's will for your life? Is it for you to be healed? Set free? How about being strong in Him? Yes, yes, and yes! Those things are His will and yet there is so much that our Heavenly Father has designed for us to walk in. What about family salvation? Yes! Sound mind? Check. Divine protection? He has that covered. Did we leave anything out? Oh yes, financial prosperity!

3 John 2 Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

Our Father's will is that we prosper in every area of our lives, and that includes financially. One may say, "Well, I'm not prospering financially." That makes you a great candidate then! Even if you are increasing, the Lord has more in store. Do you know the reason for prosperity?

Deuteronomy 8:18 But thou shalt remember the Lord thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day.

Zechariah 1:17 Cry yet, saying, thus saith the Lord of hosts; My cities through prosperity shall yet be spread abroad; and the Lord shall yet comfort Zion, and shall yet choose Jerusalem.

The Lord has designed us to prosper for the express purpose of advancing the gospel. His word said to seek first the kingdom and his righteousness. In other words, seek first the operation and advancement of the kingdom of God and His way of doing/being right; and then the rest would be added. When we put first the kingdoms' desires and how the kingdom functions, then and only then can we move on to the next stages.

We must first acknowledge our Heavenly Fathers desires. His desire, is that all men be saved and come unto the knowledge of the truth according to 1 Timothy 2:4. He loves people and sent His son to be the propitiation for our sins. When we set our minds on His desires, we can then go on to "how" are His ways of doing and being right. One of the "HOW's" is sowing and reaping.

While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease. Genesis 8:22

The story of the "Rich Young Ruler" in the Bible gives a wonderful example of the Lord's desire for people and his desire to make one wealthy.

Mark 10:17-27 And when he was gone forth into the way, there came one running, and kneeled to him, and asked him, Good Master, what shall I do that I may inherit eternal life? And Jesus said unto him, why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God. Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Defraud not, Honour thy father and mother. And he answered and said unto him, Master, all these have I observed from my youth. Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing thou lackest: go thy way, sell whatsoever thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow me. And he was sad at that saying and went away grieved: for he had great possessions. And Jesus looked round about, and saith unto his disciples, How hardly shall they that have riches enter into the kingdom of God! And the disciples were astonished at his words. But Jesus answereth again, and saith unto them, Children, how hard is it for them that trust in riches to enter into the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle, than for a rich man to enter into the kingdom of God. And they were astonished out of measure, saying among themselves, Who then can be saved? And Jesus looking upon them saith, With men it is impossible, but not with God: for with God all things are possible.

As you can see, the young man was already rich before he came to Jesus. Yet, the Lord said to him he was missing one thing. Sell everything he has and sow it to the poor. He said give it, but in this equation, it would be the same as sowing it. Once he had done that, he was then to take up the Lord's cross and follow him. As he walked away, this began another discourse; and the Lord said, no man will leave these things and I not give it back to him 100-fold in this lifetime with persecution.

He didn't say to the man, give it all away and be humble and poor. Suffer need and just starve until you get to Heaven. No, absolutely not! It was the Lord Jesus' intention to make this man a part of His ministry team and make wealthy a different way. You see, this man had not learned to prosper through sowing and reaping, but by toil. You and I can become wealthy through hard work and so forth, but we'll kill ourselves trying. There is a better way.

Now, I am not for laziness. We should work, but not in our own effort. We should work through the operation of the Holy Spirit. Move by his unction. When it comes to sowing and reaping, we do as we are led by His Spirit. Think about this: what the Lord and savior Jesus said to the man in essence was to give to the poor and become rich.

Proverbs 19:17 He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the Lord; and that which he hath given will he pay him again.

Anyone who ministers to the poor as directed by the Lord, the Lord WILL repay.

Now some may be thinking, this is just a scheme to get someone's money. Well, it is a scheme by definition. It is a plan to get YOU YOUR money. God set up the system, flow with it.

As a point of reference, meditate on these scriptures and passages. Allow this understanding to get into your heart and then apply it.
