



MONTH OF MIRACLES

Grace and Peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,

I trust that this letter finds you walking in the light of faith and love. We spend our days trusting in our Lord Jesus Christ and the power of the Holy Spirit. Remember that the Kingdom of God is not in word, but in power. **1 Corinthians 2:4** *"And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power.*

He therefore that ministereth to you the spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith? **Galatians 3:5**

The word miracle comes from the Greek word *dunamis*, which means force or miraculous power. This word *dunamis* is derived from the word *dunamai*, which means to be able or possible, also to show ability. The Lord desires to show His ability in your life. Are you dealing with seemingly difficult situations or circumstances? He is able to perform what no man can. Are you facing challenges that seem insurmountable? His miraculous power is ready to show you what can be done on behalf of those who believe. How are these things to be done? By the hearing of faith.

2 Corinthians 4:13 *"We having the same spirit of faith, as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak,"* We believe therefore we speak. I like to add in the next word in verse 14. "Knowing." This word makes verse 13 very strong. You and I are to take the word of God concerning miracles and meditate on them until it fills our hearts to overflow. This doesn't have to take long. Just eat. Feed on the word of God concerning miracles and watch the anxiety, fear, and worry dissipate and fade away.

Do you know how many miracles happened in scripture? Let's take a look at a few to whet your appetite.

Acts 3:1-9 *"Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour. And a certain man lame from his mother's womb was carried, whom they laid daily at the gate of the temple which is called Beautiful, to ask alms of them that entered into the temple; who seeing Peter and John about to go into the temple asked an alms. And Peter, fastening his eyes upon him with John, said, Look on us. And he gave heed unto them, expecting to receive of them. Then Peter said, Silver and gold have I none; but such as I have give I thee: In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth rise up and walk. And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength. And he leaping up stood, and walked, and entered with him into the temple, walking, and leaping, and praising God. And all people saw him walking and praising God."*

Matthew 9:27-35 *“And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying and saying, Thou Son of David, have mercy on us. And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord. Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. And their eyes were opened: and Jesus straitly charged them, saying, See that no man know it. But they, when they departed, spread abroad his fame in all that country. As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a devil. And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel. But the Pharisees said, He casteth out devils through the prince of devils. And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and disease among the people.*

Take a look at the miracles of the Bible and think about them. Put yourself in those situations and see yourself receiving your miracle. The Lord is showing His ability in your life this month. Receive in Jesus' name.
